## **A NOTE FROM THE NURSE'S OFFICE:**

### **IMMUNIZATIONS:**

If your child will be going into K or 7<sup>th</sup> grade there are certain immunizations due. A letter was mailed home in March to inform you if your child needed any of these immunizations. Please bring their updated shot record to the office by August 2, 2016. If they are not in compliance with their immunizations, they will not be able to start school until they have the required immunizations. Please call if you have any questions.

### **MEDICATIONS:**

If your child has any medication in the Nurses' Office please make sure that you pick it up on the last day of school. *(A parent must pick up the medication; we are not allowed to send it with the student).*

**ALL MEDICATION REMAINING AFTER THE LAST DAY WILL BE DISCARDED, PER DIOCESAN POLICY.**

If your child will need to take any of the "allowable medications" per diocesan policy, during school hours next school year, we will need another medication form filled out and signed by the doctor. Please keep in mind only certain medications can be given at school. Antibiotics are not allowed to be given at school.
